

Make your own

Bird Feeders



You Need:

A jar of crunchy peanut butter
A pine cone that is open (not still closed up)
Some strong string
A bread and butter knife
Some seeds like sunflower, pumpkin, sesame, kibbled wheat



Method:

Time to get your hands messy....

Take the pinecone and tie the strong string round the top so it can hang.

Get the peanut butter and scoop out handfuls to smear into the open gaps in the pinecone - use the knife if you want.

Make sure you fill in all the spaces.

Once that's done tip all the seeds onto a piece of newspaper and roll the peanut buttery pine cone through the seeds - cover all the peanut butter.

Now you can hang it up in a tree, from a fence - perhaps you can put it at school, or at home or even in your local park (check with the council first!)

Maybe you could keep a diary and record what birds and how many birds you see using the feeder.



See how long it takes for all the food to be gone!



Make sure you hang it in a place that is difficult for cats to get to!!
